Declaration of High Alert and National Readiness

Great People of Iran,

Due to the misguided policies pursued for decades—policies that escalated tensions with regional and global powers without a realistic assessment of the balance of power—Iran has faced severe consequences, including a destructive war, crippling economic sanctions, and increasing external pressure. Over the past two years, Iran has become the target of multiple threats and hostile actions, and the recent 12-day escalation involving Israel and the United States is cited as a clear example.

Since the beginning of nationwide protests and strikes on 7 Dey, driven by repression and the rapid decline of the national currency, the authorities have been confronted with multiple internal crises. At the same time, foreign actors may seek to exploit this moment to justify further escalation against Iran, presenting themselves as supporters of legitimate public demands while pursuing their own strategic interests.

In this context, the spread of exaggerated or false casualty figures and inflammatory narratives by certain media outlets is viewed as an attempt to shape international opinion and create conditions for further foreign intervention—potentially pushing Iran toward destructive scenarios similar to those seen in other countries.

History provides many warnings about the long-term costs of foreign domination and intervention. Iran must not allow its national sovereignty, territorial integrity, and future to be decided by external powers or imposed proxies.

For this reason, the National Council of Iran's Revolution declares a state of maximum national vigilance and calls on all patriotic citizens to strengthen **civil unity, disciplined non-violent organization, and national solidarity**, in order to protect Iran from both internal collapse and external intervention.
