#### Will the Nation Score the 90th-Minute Goal by Declaring Support for the National Council of Iran's Revolution?

It is said that a crisis is a sudden blow to the core or peripheral components of a system, disrupting its balance and stability, accompanied by major losses, contradictions or lack of information, and limited time for decision-making.

War has also been described as the continuation of politics by different means.

And revolutionary escalation occurs when those at the top can no longer govern as before, and those at the bottom can no longer—or no longer wish to—obey as before.

Now that, according to the above definitions, a **crisis-war-revolutionary situation—and even revolutionary escalation**— is clearly prevailing in Iran, we present the following points to you, the great people of Iran:

1. The aforementioned situation has placed the Islamic Republic in its **weakest position**, a reality that Mr. Marco Rubio highlighted today.
2. The weakness of the regime has given Trump the **opportunity** to once again raise the dual deadlock of **unconditional surrender or war**.
3. Accepting Trump's conditions—which form a long list—would turn Iran into a **toothless, clawless, and defenseless lion**, deprived of even minimal deterrent power; rejecting this option would also **trigger war**, the prerequisites of which have already been prepared.
4. We have previously stated that this dual deadlock of humiliating unconditional surrender or war is not merely about taking the removed leader “to the top of the pass,” but in reality it is the **great nation of Iran** that is being taken there.
5. We have also previously stated that the **conduct of governments**, even illegal and illegitimate ones, is ultimately **attributed to their nations**, and it is the nations who pay the price.
6. Since a year ago, when rumors began with Trump's return to the White House, we repeatedly said that the only way out of this dual deadlock is a **national uprising under conditions of urgency and necessity**, but there were no willing listeners.
7. Now the great nation of Iran—**mourning an unprecedented massacre**, returning from the streets **empty-handed**—stands at the center of the triad of **crisis, war, and revolution**, and as noted in the definition of crisis, there is **insufficient time** for decision-making, while the enemy is closely monitoring the situation and will seize the opportunity.
8. In effect, Trump and Netanyahu regard our country as **ownerless**, because its regime is not only **illegitimate** but also suffers from **profound incompetence**. Thus, Iran's enemies have concluded that given the regime's **extreme weakness**, they can impose any humiliating agreement upon it—and if it refuses, they will **wage war** to **fragment and destroy** our country.
9. Iran's current coordinates are as follows: an **illegitimate and ineffective government** with an **empty treasury**, a **grieving nation** caught in **crisis, war, and revolution**, and an

opposition of which part is chasing illusions while another part supports **foreign aggression**. Our own voice—having learned patriotism from the leader of the national movement, **Dr. Mohammad Mossadegh**—does not reach the people due to **media weakness**. Had it reached them, we could have achieved remarkable results on the basis of **popular support and legitimacy**, including:

- a. Demonstrating that Iran is not an **ownerless country** upon which any bully may impose an illegitimate will.
- b. Calling the people to follow a **roadmap** that passes through **nationwide strikes and civil disobedience**, first to prevent further **massacres** of our youth, and second to lead the **national uprising to victory**, thereby depriving foreign powers of both the **motivation** and the **audacity** to attack our country.
- c. Telling Mr. Trump, based on established principles of international law and the UN Charter, that he has **no right even to threaten Iran**, let alone wage war, and that the eras of coercive diplomacy are long over.
- d. Telling all governments, including the United States, that any agreement concluded under pressure with the Islamic Republic would be **null and void** for two reasons: first, because the Islamic Republic lacks legitimacy and does not represent the Iranian nation; second, because coercion, pressure, and threats invalidate such agreements.
- e. Transforming national division into **unity** and unity into **national solidarity**, changing the **balance of power** in favor of the people, removing the illegitimate regime's grip on power, eliminating foreign **pretexts for aggression**, and turning national solidarity into a **state of national readiness** so that foreign powers understand the reality.
- f. Forming a **transitional government** under the supervision of the National Council of Iran's Revolution to prevent a power vacuum, chaos, and revenge, administer the country as a normal government, hold a referendum on the system of governance within one year, elect a constituent assembly to draft a new constitution, submit that constitution to referendum, and upon approval, establish new governing institutions and transfer power to a permanent government elected by the people.

It is self-evident that **your support**, the great people of Iran, for your National Council of Revolution is the guarantee of the success of these efforts. Without your declaration of support, these plans will remain mere aspirations.
